


2010 Peirson Meyer Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

We first produced the Peirson Meyer Cabernet in 2005. Since that time we have continued to craft what we consider to be the ideal expression of Cabernet Sauvignon to represent the Peirson Meyer brand. Classic varietal character and a refined elegance and presence is what we seek to achieve; a wine of nuance and balance, intrigue and finesse. The 2010 represents our personal best of what Cabernet Sauvignon offered in 2010. Aromas of fresh currents, ripe berries, and fig, mingle with nuances of light clove, vanilla, and anise, highlighted with perfumed floral notes. The wine glides across the palate with richness and velvety tannins, and finishes with with a smooth, yet persistent mouthfeel.

The 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon is drop-dead gorgeous. Black cherries, mint, violets, new leather and spices are all woven together in a fabric of notable class and sheer elegance. Not an obvious wine, at least today, the 2010 impresses for its silky tannins and phenomenal overall balance. The 2010 is a vibrant, mid-weight wine that impresses for its class and pure harmony. This is a typical mountain wine in 2010 long on freshness and vibrancy but perhaps missing a bit of mid-palate density. Still, this elegant, polished Cabernet Sauvignon is drop-dead gorgeous. Anticipated maturity: 2014-2025. -95 pts.
