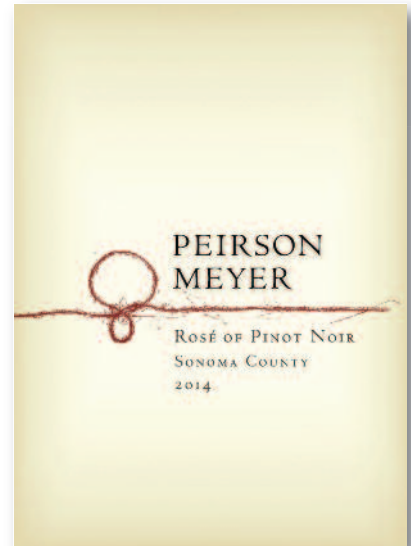

**Winemaker Notes**

Our 2014 Rosé of Pinot Noir is rich with aromas of fresh strawberries, white peaches, and sweet cream. Delicate floral notes come and go with the beautiful fruit aromas. The mouthfeel is silky smooth with a nice touch of acidity to keep the palate lively and focused. Enjoy this wine all summer long.

**Vineyard Notes**

Our Sonoma County Rosé is a blend from two vineyards that both lie at approximately 700 feet above sea level, near Occidental. Both are planted in Goldridge soils. The vines are trained on a vertical trellis system (VSP) on north eastern facing slopes that offer protection from the hot summer afternoon sun

- Aged sur lees for 5 months
- Bottled in April 2015
