Winemaker Notes

Sourced from the Kenefick Ranch on Picket Road in Calistoga, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon selection offers aromas of black cherries, ripe berries, and plums. Spicy elements of clove and anise highlight the deeper mineral notes of graphite and slate. This wine has an amazingly smooth entry that opens to a broad and well structured palate. The aromatics definitely carry through to the palate and the delicious fruit qualities linger on the palate.

The 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon (also from the Kenefick Ranch in Napa) was aged 20 months in 75% new French oak, and is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Its deep cassis flavors, full-bodied power, and classic Napa style with plenty of glycerin and intensity suggest it will drink well for 15+ years.- 91 pts.
