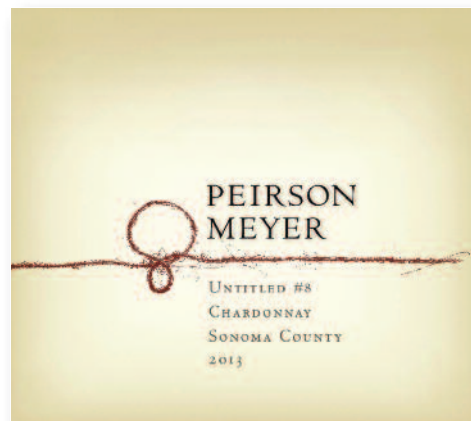

The 2013 Chardonnay Untitled No. 8 shows more smoky, hazelnut characteristics and in a very tiny cuvée. It reminds me of a premier cru Meursault with its smokiness and tropical fruit. It is definitely a different take on Chardonnay by Peirson Meyer. - 94 points
