

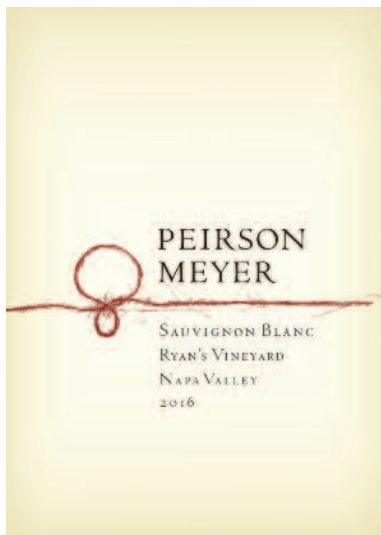

The 2016 Sauvignon Blanc Ryan's Vineyard is gorgeous. A wine of total distinction and class, the 2016 offers a striking interplay of varietal notes and texture. Sage, mint and pear notes add nuance, but the Sauvignon Blanc is above all else a wine of balance and harmony. Aging in neutral oak adds depth without dominating. - 93 pts.
