

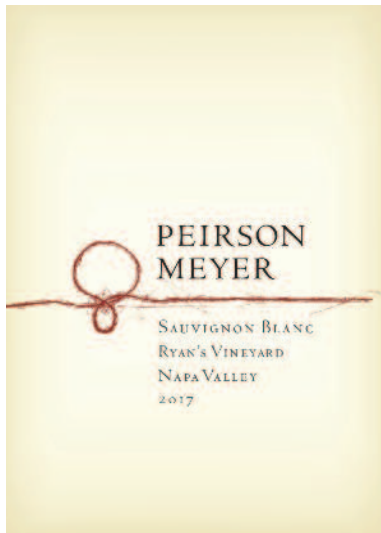

Peirson Meyer's 2017 Sauvignon Blanc is bright, perfumed and gracious, with lovely varietal character and tons of nuance. Pear, white flowers, mint and apple are nicely delineated in this very pretty Sauvignon Blanc. Aging in barrel on the lees brings out terrific texture and depth. - 92 pts.
