

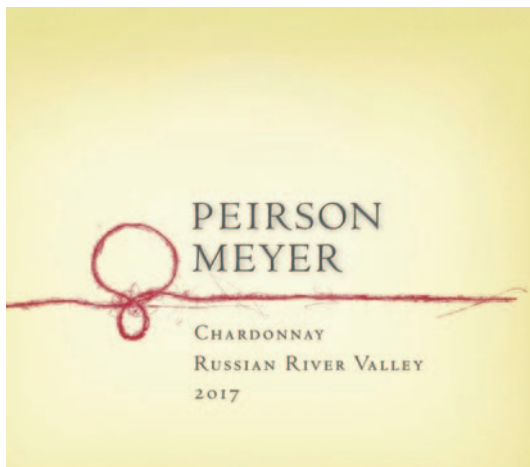

With plenty of fresh fruit up front, our 2017 Chardonnay blend flourishes with notes of white peach, Asian pear and wild spring flowers. There is a light graham cracker spice and subtle hints of candle wax that make the aromatics of this wine very compelling. Pure and silky with an elegant entry and finish, the mouthfeel maintains a surprising weight and concentration on the mid-palate.
